- Framework for Decision-making



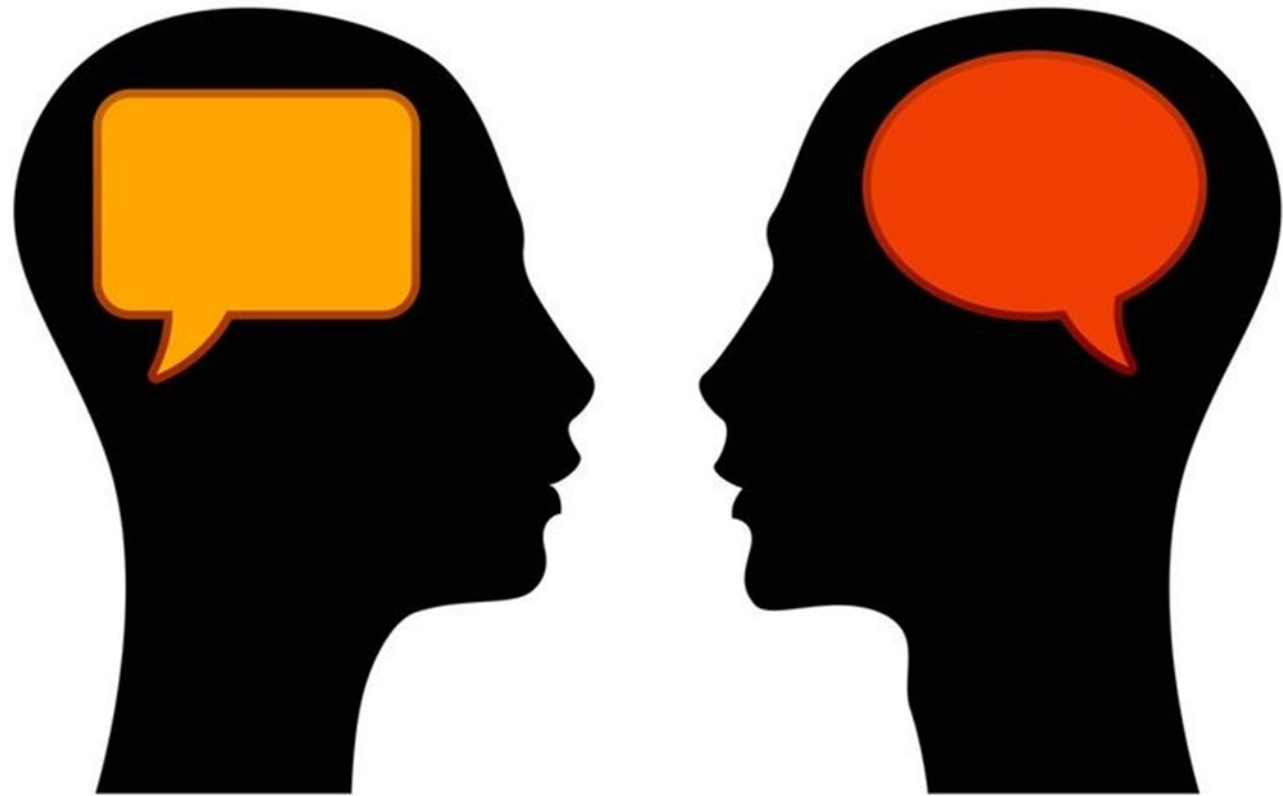
